


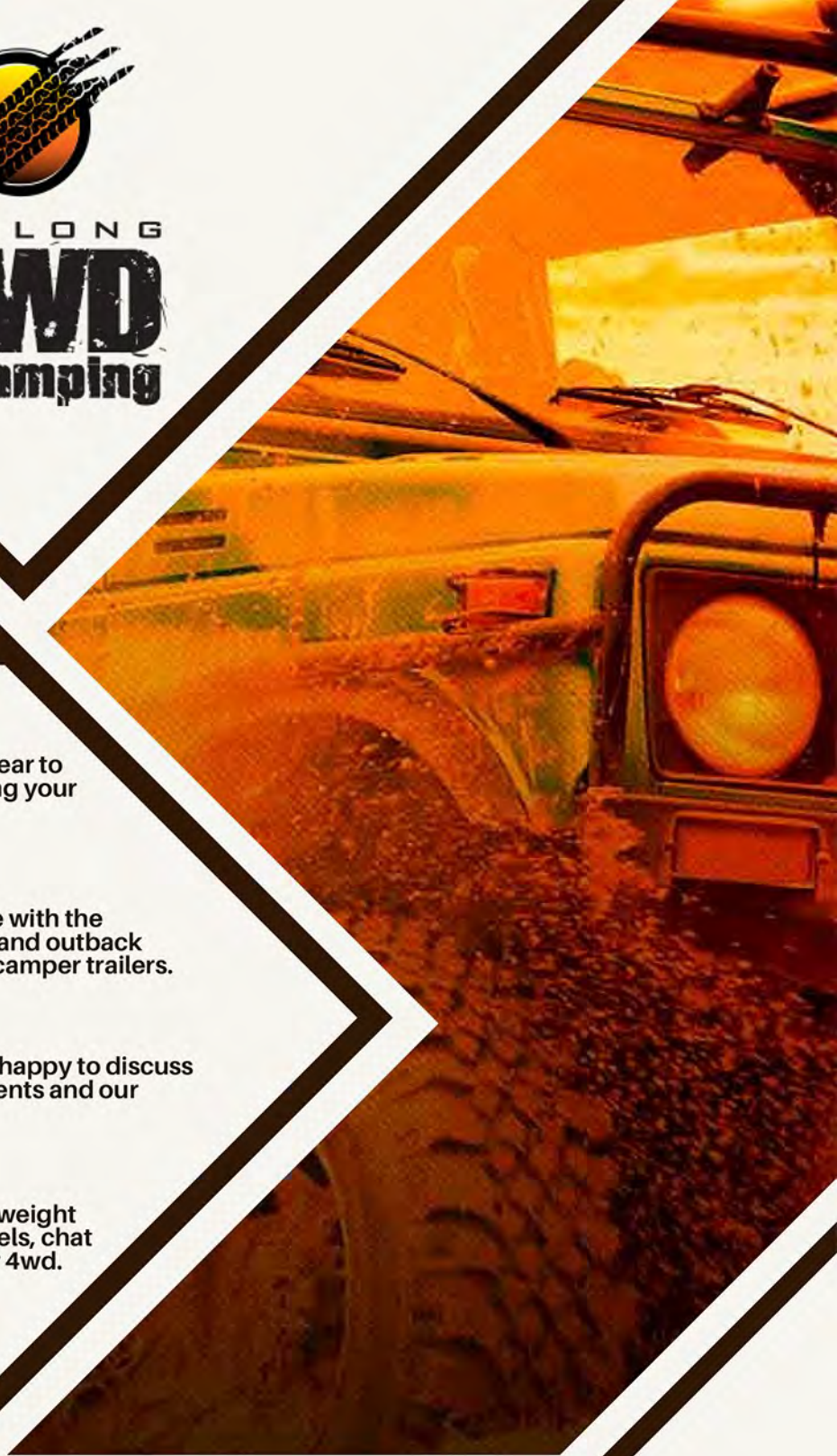

A small group of us met last Saturday night for a social night at the sprint cars.

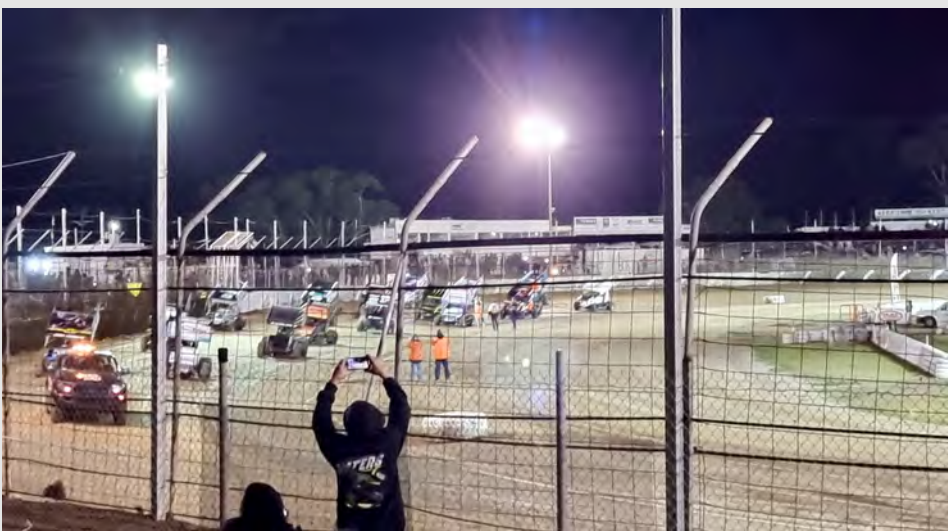
We snagged a spot near the first turn and settled in to watch the cars race. The atmosphere was great, especially as cars crashed into walls or each other.
