



This months hut focus is Mcnamaras Hut on Buckety Plain.



Located about three kilometres off the highway from Omeo to Falls Creek. Shown on the Bogong HP map a (or "Cope" map) at GR 296980. There is a sign on the main which leads onto a track.. There is a locked gate at the end of the track and then its just a short walk into the hut. The original hut was burnt in the 2003 fires.

This is one of the best examples of choc log construction huts, once a shelter for weary mountain cattlemen and later for thousands of Victorian school children. McNamara's was first built in the 1940s by a bunch of "fiery old cattlemen". It was used by "Roney" McNamara and the Naughtons of Cobungra Station, who grazed cows on the Buckety Plain run. In the 1970s, Charlie McNamara agreed to the then derelict hut being used for education, and that's when Mr Stapleton and his crew of children first fixed it up. At that stage, the hut had not been used for more than a decade. It looked, said Mr Stapleton, like it had been pulled apart. There was even a dead cow inside. This new rebuilt McNamaras Hut was built in 2004 after it burnt down in the 2003 alpine bush fires. It had been used alot over the 30 years prior to that for school camps, the scouts and venturers and the Mittagundi whom have all taken part in its upkeep and modifications over the years. The new hut was built by VHCHA in April 2004 it was an all-volunteer effort by members of the Victorian High Country Huts Association and Mittagundi.
